**GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS and OTHER FINANCIAL AID**

A limited number of Graduate Assistantships are available through the School of Music in each of the following concentrations:

Choral Conducting  
Instrumental Conducting  
Composition  
Jazz Studies  
Music Education  
Orchestral Instrument Performance  
Organ Performance  
Piano Pedagogy  
Piano Performance  
Vocal Performance

Awards are competitive and consist of full waiver of tuition plus a stipend. Generally, awards provide a monetary stipend ranging from \$3000.00 to \$5200.00. Students receiving Graduate Assistantships are required to pay applicable Student Health and Student Activities Fees that are not covered by the award package.

Those submitting an application for a graduate assistantship must either be enrolled in a School of Music graduate program or must concurrently submit an application for admission to music graduate study at Georgia State University. Recipients of awards must maintain a 3.0 GPA, carry a 12 semester hour course load and satisfactorily perform their assigned duties.

**FEE WAIVERS**

Minority Scholarships and International Fee Waivers are also granted to qualified students. Contact the Office of Admissions and Enrollment in the School of Music for further information.

**FINANCIAL AID**

Graduate students are eligible for various kinds of financial aid that are awarded by the Office of Student Financial Aid. This assistance includes scholarships, grants, loans and employment. Demonstrated need and academic achievement are important considerations. **Application packets for the next school year are available after January 1.
